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#### Registration Dates and Times

Online Registration for Early Bird Pricing will open on: 4/15

In Person Registration/ Payment can be made at the casino on 4/25 From 6:00pm - 7:30pm Or dropped at 145 Hoover Place.

Early Bird Pricing/Registration will close on 4/25 at 8pm. All payments MUST BE RECEIVED NO LATER THAN 5/1 to qualify for early bird pricing. After 5/1 you will be charged late pricing.

"Late" Registration will open on 4/26 and will close on 6/24

All "late" payments MUST be received by 6/24.

After 4/25 Payment can be dropped at 145 Hoover Place.

Please note that early registration will close on 4/25.

It will re-open with updated pricing the following day 4/26.

If you need assistance you can stop down at the Casino on registration night. 4/25; 6-7:30.


Payment of 50% is due on registration night at the

## REGISTRATION CONTINUED

Last minute sign-up/drop-off the week of is NOT permitted. Campers must be signed up AT LEAST the Week Prior.



#### CAMP COSTS THIS YEAR

- ★ \$199 Week of Registration 50% non- refundable deposit required, Full Amount Due by May 1st
- \* Multiple family member discount for 3 or more children...
  - \* \$ 180 for 3rd and 4th Child
  - ★ Week 1 is a shortened week; \$160 for the week, early registration, \$185 regular registration (no multi-child discount for this week)
    - ★ Must be registered by 6/24 to attend sessions 1-4
    - ★ Must be registered by 7/25 to attend sessions 5-7
    - \* \$ 229 Late registration. Payment due by 6/24
      - \* \$205 for 3rd and 4th child
        - ★ CIT's \$35 Per Week

## CAMP GROUPS

Each group will continue to have a limited number of campers. For safety reasons the camper to counselor ratio must be kept at 3:1.

The groups will have 2 counselors each as well as CITs.

Sports, Art, Theater will have 1 main counselor along with an assistant CIT.

Counselors and CITs will stay with their own group of campers for the entirety of the day.

## PICK UP AND DROP OFF

Each group will have a designated area. This is where your child will be dropped off and picked up from each day.

ARE NOT permitted to
stay with their child
during camp hours.\*\*\*

Pre K & K will be dropped off at/in the Casino.

1st will be under the awning behind the casino.

2, 3, 4 will be dropped off under the pavilion.

5, 6, 7 will be under the tent by the playground.

All drops off locations are subject to change depending on the number of campers in each group.

Pickups will occur in the same location.

## CAMP RULES THAT ARE STAYING IN PLACE

For the safety of all campers and CIT's

Campers must stay with their group for the day.
Unless given permission by their counselor.
Counselors must know where their campers are at all times. CITS must also stay with their group.

Campers must move with their group to the different activities throughout the day. They unfortunately can't hang at a preferred activity to avoid a less preferred activity. For example, if a group is moving from Sports to Art, everyone has to go to art, they can't stay at sports.

There will be a one warning into a zero tolerance policy in place for all campers, so it's important you speak to your children about this.

This rule applies for counselors and CIT's as well.



#### WHAT HAPPENS IF SOMEONE TESTS POSITIVE?

Unfortunately we still have to deal with COVID, thankfully it is not as bad as last summer.

If your child tests positive:

- 1. Notify me immediately. I will notify close contacts.
- 2. Call the DOH and inform them that your child tested positive, inform them that your child is a camper at HBCA and provide them with my phone number (516) 381-8577
- 3. We will follow current quarantine guidelines.
- 4. As I am writing this The NYSDOH says A positive Test needs to quarantine for 5 days and then wear a mask for 6-10 after release from quarantine.
- 5. All COVID protocols are subject to change based on the latest CDC guidance.


In Lieu of parent volunteers this year we are continuing to offer families 2 options; (However we will need 4 parent volunteers)
