Beach Cleanup Day

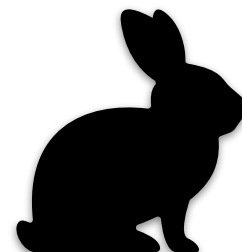
Saturday, April 25, 9:00am to 3:00pm

REGISTER FOR SUMMER REC!

Early registration will take place from Monday, March 30th to Friday, April 3rd. All registration will be done online through our new platform, Cheddar Up, which can be accessed via the QR code on this page. ALL early registration must be completed and payment is due ON or BEFORE April 3rd.



In-person registration will take place on April 23rd in the casino. This is the only time cash or paper checks will be accepted. If you choose to pay cash on April 23rd, you **MUST** register online first* and then bring the cash payment to the casino.

*Failure to make the cash payment on 4/23 will result in a deleted registration, and you will need to pay via CC or e-check, both of which are subject to processing fees, and the early bird discount will no longer be honored.

Open to children of HBCA members in good standing. Campers entering pre-K (4 years old by 12/1/25 and potty-trained) to those entering 7th

grade. CITs are entering 8th and 9th grade.

Camp held Monday through Friday from 9:15am to 2:15pm for seven weeks starting June 29th through the week of August 10th.

NEW THIS SUMMER: there will be **extended hours** offered (2:15pm to 3:15pm) from **July 6th** to the final camp week of August 10th. **LIMITED SPACES AVAILABLE;** 30 slots per session.
